

## 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Memory Work 2018-2019

Memory work will be due every Friday. If we do not have school on Friday, it will be due that Thursday. The bible verses will be spoken orally to me. The hymn verses and the catechism selections will be fill-in-the-blank. Students will also be required to write the selection two times by Thursday, and I will take a grade on this.

### August 17<sup>th</sup> - 1 Corinthians 15:57

So we too will sincerely forgive and gladly do good to those who sin against us.**

**April 5th- 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment**

***What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.**

**May 3rd - 8<sup>th</sup> Commandment**

**You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.**

***What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.**

**May 10th- 9<sup>th</sup> Commandment**

**You shall not covet your neighbor's house.**

***What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get them in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.**

**May 17th - 10<sup>th</sup> Commandment**

**You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.**

***What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.**
